By using the advanced UC to direct incoming callers to desired extensions the university will eliminate excess drain on resources.

The UC platform is also being used to broadcast messages, such as inclement weather or campus announcements, to the student body via their cell phone.

In order to ensure the new system is being utilized to its full potential, Paul Quinn College has also installed AccuCall-Web Advanced, a call reporting application. This call accounting application provides the ability to monitor and track day-to-day business performance, and reveals any costly errors or historical network issues. Generated reports can also be used to pinpoint the location of any misuse or abuse of the system's resources.
